The statement below is a Confidentiality Contract which RCC requires to be signed by all parties who request services as a coach or therapist. It is for the purpose of protecting information discussed during therapeutic sessions from being used outside the session in such circumstances as court cases, either through subpoenas or in any way requested by any party to use in subsequent adversarial or collateral situations.

## Confidentiality Contract for Therapy

This contract is an agreement between the interested party(ies) that no one shall for any reason attempt to subpoen my testimony or my records to be presented in a deposition or court hearing of any kind for any reason, such as a divorce or custody case. I/we understand that it is Resolve Counseling Center's policy to have no court involvement in a client(s) case because that could harm our professional relationship and the ability to achieve client(s)goals. Client(s) goals include resolving personal/relationship concerns so that client(s) might live an emotionally healthy life which will result in healthier relationships. I/we understand that therapy involves need to speak freely. I/we acknowledge that the goal of therapy, either individual, family, marital or couples therapy, is for the purpose of the amelioration of psychological distress and that the process of psychotherapy depends on trust and openness during the therapy sessions. Therefore, it is understood by myself/all parties that if therapy services are requested with Resolve Counseling Center, I/we are expected not to use information given to the therapist during the therapeutic process against the another party in a judicial setting of any kind, be it civil, criminal, or circuit.
